Re: Extension of Online Learning, Refunds, Etc. – Grades 3-11

Greetings from RAIS!

Due to the concerns of safety of our students, parents, and teachers, we would like to inform you that, with our present situation, our online classes will continue till **June 2, 2021**. Our teachers have been working hard with our students to provide an excellent education. We have received a lot of compliments from the parents for the dedicated services rendered by the teachers. We are thankful for your unending support always.

The school administration has revised the **May to July calendar** as well as some possible refunds and other useful announcements as follows:

Following is the tentative plan for Grades 3-11:

1. **Online Classes** - Online classes will continue till **June 2, 2021** (If the situation improves, we will inform you as to when it is possible to come back to school).
2. **4th Quarter Examinations** - There will **not be any exams for all subjects for the 4th quarter**. The school administration and the teachers will grade students on their class performance.
3. **Missing Work** - To support students in completion of their **missing work**, we have given **May 25 to June 2, 2021**. These days are designated to help complete all the missing work. All teachers will help support our students with their missing work and will help improve their grades.
4. **Free Online Summer School Program** - The school administration has decided to offer **free** online classes from **June 16-July 23, 2021**. This is in support due to the current crisis. Please note that all learning resources for summer school will be provided online. However, if the government permits on campus instruction, the school will inform the students to come to school, but there will be **no charges involved (free)**. All students will be in the next grade for summer school. For example, if a student is in grade 3 this school year, during summer school the student will be placed in grade 4.
5. **Summer School Registration** – A google form will be sent to you regarding summer school registration. Please complete and return it to us to indicate your child's participation by **June 2, 2021**.
6. **Extension of Voucher** - For those RAIS registered students of SY2019-2020, the summer school voucher that was provided last academic year will be extended to summer of **2022-2023** academic year. Students can utilize it the summer of next academic year (**2021-2022**) or the summer of the following academic year (**2022-2023**).



7. **Refund for Summer School Payment** - For parents who have registered and paid for summer school this year (2020-2021), the school will **fully refund** the amount you have paid.
8. **Refund for School Van** – For parents who are using the school van services and have already paid the fees, the school administration will refund the school van fees. The school personnel will get in touch with you concerning this matter.
9. **Refund for Afterschool Classes** – For parents who have already paid for afterschool classes, the school administration will refund for the days that the afterschool classes were not met. The school personnel will get in touch with you concerning this matter.
10. **Refund for Pathfinder Camp Fee** – For parents of Grades 5-8 who have paid the Pathfinder fee, the fee of the Pathfinder camp will be refunded due to the missing of the camp. The school personnel will get in touch with you concerning this matter.
11. **Return of Textbooks** – When the situation is deemed appropriate and it is safe, we will inform you about the return of the textbooks. A letter will be sent to inform about the schedule to return the textbooks.


