The school administration would like to share the following important information for next academic year 2021-2022:

# 1. School Fees for Grade 1-12 and EFL

- 1.1. Grade 1 & 2 Lunch Fee Parents who have paid the lunch fee, the fee will be refunded. The new rate will be calculated based on the number of onsite classes. An invoice will be sent when the onsite classes begin. Parents who have not paid the lunch fee, please wait until the onsite classes begin.
- 1.2. Free After-School Help The school will provide assistance to help the students during online classes. This after school assistance is free of charge. # 3. General Information

### 3.1. Online Schedule

- 3.2. Online Classes All online class sessions will be recorded and will be posted in the Google Classroom. This will help the students to review the class session.
- 3.3. Student Attendance The teachers will mark attendance every school day for all periods. If your child is unable to attend the classes, please inform the teacher.

### 3.4. Materials for School

- a. The school will only require important materials for online classes. Once the onsite classes begin the teachers will send the complete list of materials required for the school year.
- b. Returning Textbooks Students who have not returned the textbooks, please return them by August 6, 2021. The school personnel will contact you to pick up the books from your place if you are not able to bring them yourself to school.
- c. New Textbooks We request you to contact the office to pick up the new textbooks from today until August 15, 2021, to be ready for the classes. Please note that the office is not open on Saturdays and public holidays. On Sundays, the office is open from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon.
- 3.5. **Assessment** Teachers will assess students' progress regularly. Classwork, homework, tests, and quizzes will be scheduled and informed to students. We request parents to check MyGrade to know the progress of your children. Teachers will give make up time to complete the missing work. Please note that the school expects the students to submit the assignments before the deadline. We request parents to be understanding regarding the submission of work. If your child experiences any technical difficulties and is not able to submit the work on or before the deadline date, please inform the teachers immediately.
- 3.6. After-School Program Parents who require special individualized sessions may contact the PR office and they will inform you the details of the payment and schedule.
  - a. Grade 1-4, EFL: Teacher Assistants will be online from 15:00 to 19:00 every school
  - b. Grade 5-12: Teachers will schedule time after school to help those who need more assistance to complete assignments.
- 3.7. School Gmail Accounts We request all students to change their passwords due to security reasons.

### 3.8. Curriculum and Instruction

- a. The school administration will regularly monitor all the online classes to make sure that curriculum and instruction requirements are met.
- b. Please note that the activity subject curriculums and activities will be modified to suit online learning.





- 3.9. Student Course Outlines The teachers will send the student course outlines through Google Classroom during the first week of school. Please take note of the coverage for each quarter.
- 3.10. School Calendar The school calendar was sent to all parents; however, it will be reviewed based on the situation and government requirements. Please take note of the attached revised calendar. (See Attachment 3)
- 3.11. Military Training for Grade 10-12 Boys The school will notify the parents about the military training program when updates are available. As of the information available right now, the training will be conducted online.

# 4. Guidance Department, Online Programs, and Activities

### 4.1. Guidance Activities

- a. The counselors will attend classes to present about guidance activities during the first two weeks.
- b. The counselors will attend the Parent Orientation on the dates mentioned in 2.2
- c. We will invite parents to participate during specific guidance programs, such as career week and other activities planned by the Guidance department.
- d. Online Guidance Classes for students will take place during chapel periods, worship time, Bible class. Topics will include cyber bullying awareness, health and wellness, reproductive health, sex education for MS & HS students, overcoming depression, etc.

### 4.2. Communication

- a. Regular communication will be done with parents to check on any concerns regarding students' over-all wellbeing.
- b. The counselors will attend online classes to assist students with challenges.
- c. Individual and group counselling will take place via Google Classroom, LINE, or other means of communication.

# 4.3. Special Educational Needs (SEN) Information

- a. Full-time SEN Students: the guidance department will inform parents individually about the class plans and activities.
- b. Pull-out Program will start when onsite classes begin.

# 6. School Updates

- 6.1. Vaccination We are glad to inform you that RAIS faculty, staff, and teachers are COVID-vaccinated, and their second dose is scheduled for August, September, and October.
- 6.2. **School Improvement** The school administration is always finding ways to improve the facilities to enhance student learning.
  - a. Walkway The walkway between building C and D and in front of the cafeteria has been renovated.

# b. Music Department

- i. Curriculum & Resources The music curriculum has undergone revision to integrate Trinity College London standards. A video of the program will be made available through our school website. The school also purchased music teaching resources that will help achieve the revised curriculum.
- ii. Classrooms The 5th floor of building D2 has been restructured to provide soundproof music classes.











- c. Hi-speed Wi-Fi By November 2021, building C will be fully equipped with a Hispeed wi-fi system.
- d. Purchase of Online Resources The school is improving its online learning resources and instructional delivery to effect student learning. This school year, interactive online applications are acquired to enhance teaching and learning and improve student's online engagement.
- e. Renovation of SEN Facilities The 3rd floor of building E was restructured to provide spacious classrooms for SEN students for their learning activities.
