Subject: 1st Quarter Examinations and Onsite Classes

Greetings from RAIS! We hope that this letter will find you safe and in good health. In less than a month's time we will be completing the 1st quarter of the 2021/2022 school year. We get many queries from our students as to when we plan to end virtual classes.

We would like to share with our parents and students the oncoming events before the end of the 1st quarter and the open of classrooms for students under the **'Sandbox Safety Zone in School'**. Please pay attention to these important guidelines:

- Quarter Examinations/Tests The examinations will be limited to the chapter tests which are covered prior to the end of the quarter. These tests will be completed by the 7th of October 2021. Teachers will schedule the dates for these tests and inform the students. Please take note that regular teaching will take place when there are no tests scheduled.
- <u>Time for Missing Work</u> The school has scheduled October 8th, 11th, and 12th, 2021 as regular school days where teachers will help students to complete their missing work and/or redo work for a grade improvement.
- 3. <u>October Holidays</u> October 13th -15th, 2021 is scheduled as holiday. We hope that this holiday will help all our students and parents to have a quality relaxing time before 2nd quarter starts.

- 4. Vaccination The Ministry of Education has provided information on the need for vaccination. Subsequently, we sent a survey to G7-G12 parents on September 15, 2021, regarding the vaccination for students of ages 12-17. The school is working with the Ministry of Education to facilitate vaccination for the students. When the school receives more information from the authorities regarding place, date, and time, we will send you the details.
- 5. October Online School Calendar The revised calendar for the month of October is attached with this letter. We request you to follow the events scheduled in the calendar.
- 6. Sandbox Safety Zone in School The school administration, faculty and staff are working and following additional protocols on safety of our students when onsite learning happens. Once when the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Public Health allow the schools to have onsite classes, we will inform you of the additional policy concerns. Our aim for onsite classes is to be in line with the Ministry of Education's target of reopening the schools.

RAIS has taken measures to ensure the safety of every student and everyone at school. We appreciate the help and support of all our parents. It is our hope and prayer that you are safe and enjoying good health. We pray that God will bless and keep you from every harm and danger.
